Dear Parents and Carers,

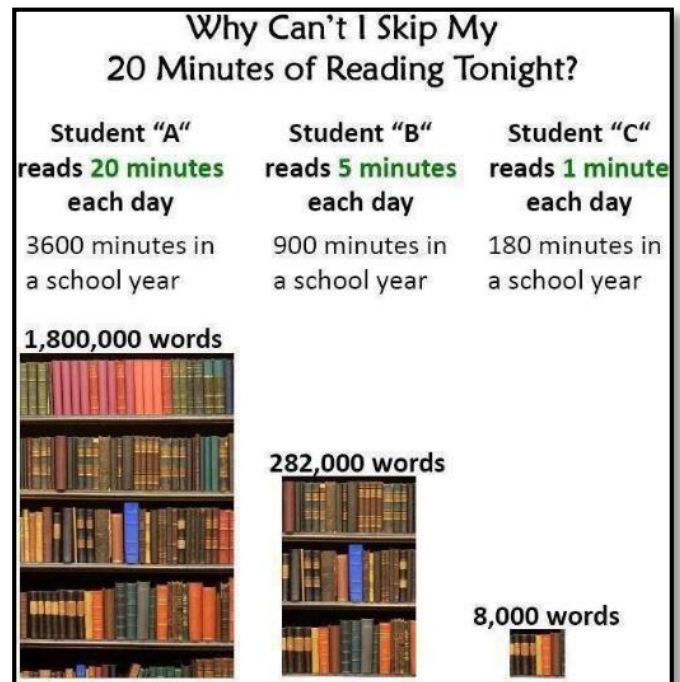
Welcome to Term 2! The students have settled back into their school routines and are demonstrating great enthusiasm towards their learning. We have a very busy and exciting term ahead!

Attendance

Reading and Writing

This term in reading we will be developing our skills in predicting, making connections to personal experiences, pausing to think about what we have read and making inferences and summarising important events or information in the text.

In writing this term we will be focusing on free weekend writing, recounts, procedures and explanations. We are continuing to enhance our writing by making sure we use the description bubble, time connectives and punctuation to make our writing powerful!

Inquiry

Our term two inquiry learning will focus on Science.

The first unit, '**All Mixed Up**' will involve students developing understandings about materials that don't mix well, and others that are difficult to separate. Through hands-on investigations, students will explore how changing the quantities of materials in a mixture can alter its properties and uses. They will complete a mini-project at home about mixtures. '**Stimulating Science**' is the unit of inquiry that we will be investigating for the remainder of the term. Students will explore the concept of changes in our physical world and develop understandings of how and why these changes occur, helping us in our daily lives.

Our guiding questions will include;

- What changes every day?
- How does a scientist work?
- Why are there different categories of science?

Maths

As part of our whole school Maths Initiative, we will continue to spend three weeks on a specific topic to consolidate student understandings.

- Subtraction
- Place Value
- Shapes and Objects
- Patterns

Digital Technologies

This term students will continue to explore digital systems and coding through the use of Bee Bots and programs including Scratch Junior.

Library

Students are able to borrow up to four books and can have them for up to two weeks.

Students need to use either their reader bag or bring a library bag for this session. Please see attached individual classroom timetable for specific classroom times.

If your child has an overdue book they will not be able to borrow from the library.

Chinese

After a quick recap of numbers of 1 to 10, students will learn to count from 11 to 19 as well as counting by 10s. Students will also learn 8 animal words in Chinese through several learning activities such as actions, singing and role plays. By the end of the term, students are supposed to be able to tell two sentences in Chinese – 'I am + animal' and 'I have + numbers of animals at home'.



Music

In music this term, Grade Two students will continue to explore how music is used in different contexts. They will have the opportunity to respond to the musical elements of Rhythm/Beat, Tempo and Pitch by using body percussion techniques as well as tuned and non-tuned percussion instruments such as Xylophones, Glockenspiels, Claves and Guiros. Students will also have opportunities to perform to the class where they will demonstrate the creative work we have been covering in class in individual and group performances. There will also be a music listening component whereby students can express the sounds they hear through creative responses such as drawing and movement.



Art

In art this term grade one and two students will explore ideas and observations and express them through the subject matter of their artworks. They will experiment with different materials, techniques and processes to make artwork in a range of forms. Students will continue to develop an understanding of the elements of art focussing on shape, texture and colour to create artworks based on picture books, winter and ANZAC themes. They will continue to develop their construction techniques through paper folding, cutting and joining. Students will use arts language to discuss their own and others artworks.



PE

During Term 2 students will be working on fundamental motor skills such as running, leaping, throwing and catching. Students will also be involved in minor games working on team work, encouraging others and following game rules. Students will also be practicing a range of Athletic events to prepare for the School Athletics early in Term 3.
